Project Success Teamwork Building High-Performing Teams and Leaders

Target Audience:

This program is designed for individuals who are or will be leaders or key members of project teams. The number of participants will be limited to no more than 30 per session. Participants should have completed a two-day YCA project management program to ensure proper understanding of the concepts, principles, and techniques of project planning and control.

Description and Learning Objectives:

This course focuses on: (a) recognizing the characteristics of effective project teams and team leaders, (b) developing effective teams/leaders, and (c) maintaining the effectiveness of teams/leaders in the face of potentially disruptive forces.

Upon completion of this program, participants will be able to:

1. Describe a system of factors and relationships that determine the overall effectiveness of project team performance.
2. Identify the essential characteristics of effective project teams.
3. Describe the desirable personal attributes of project leaders.
4. Recognize alternative sources of influence in leadership situations.
5. Describe the dimensions of leadership style, and analyze project situations to determine the appropriate emphasis on each dimension.
6. Identify key requirements of group decision-making processes.
7. Apply formal team building processes, including the development of team charters.
8. Identify sources of conflict in projects, and analyze project situations to select the most appropriate method for resolving conflict.
