## PMP® Prep Program

### **Target Audience:**

This course is intended for those individuals seeking to pass the PMP® certification examination administered by the Project Management Institute (PMI). The audience will be limited to eight and no more than 15 participants per program.

### **Objective:**

The objective of the course is simple: At the conclusion of this PMP® Prep Program, participants should be able to pass the PMP® Certification Examination administered by PMI.

**Program Guarantee:** *If a participant completes the three-day PMP® Prep Program and fails to pass the PMI PMP certification exam, then the participant may take the program again for free.*

**Major Topics:** The course is organized around the Project Management Knowledge areas covered by the Project Management Institute's PMP® exam. Although there are other organizing frameworks for such a course, this framework is most practical for the purpose of PMP® preparation.

A comprehensive preparation manual is provided to each course participant. Each chapter in the course manual contains several pages of background and review material followed by a set of extensive review questions that mimic the questions encountered on the actual PMP® exam. The review questions in each section are followed by answers.

An introductory section is included in the course manual that addresses general information about the PMP® designation and the examination. A second section is included to address an overview of the framework and organization of the Project Management Body of Knowledge (PMBOK®). A closing section is also included in the manual to address PMP® exam questions related to Professional and Social Responsibility – a section covered on the PMP® exam, but not a “knowledge area” in PMBOK®.

The other sections of the manual address specific knowledge areas in the PMBOK®.

**Prerequisites:** Each participant is assumed to have taken a basic course in project management. If not, we recommend the two-day Project Success Method program in the fundamentals of project management. Additionally, participants are expected to have participated in managing projects and should have received or will be receiving approval to take the PMP Exam from PMI.

**Program Duration:** 3 days
